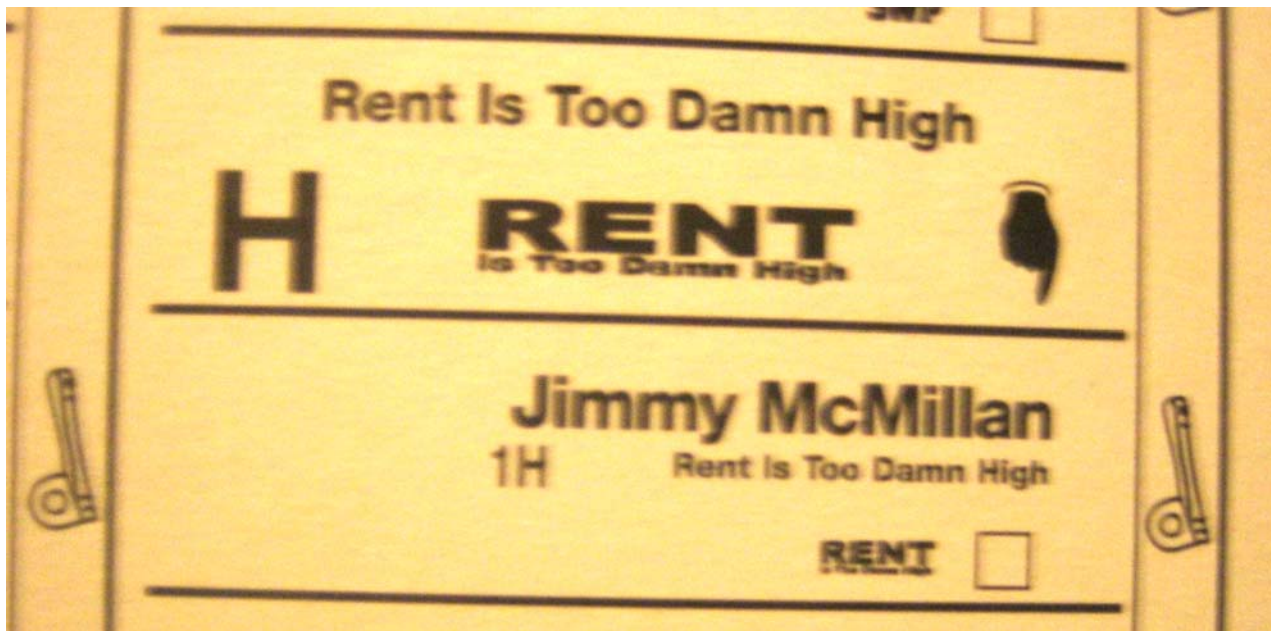
1. **For Socialism and Liberation Party = 25 Letters (See Exhibit-1)**

“The Rent Is Too Damn High Party” made it on the ballot in 2005 in it’s entirety. Why is there a problem now (in 2009) when you are using the same voting machines?

“Party for Socialism and Liberation Party” is longer than “Rent Is Too Damn High Party” (Per the Board of Election Records). I was also told that the party name “Rent Is Too Damn High” was cut down for “RELIGIOUS REASONS”.
